## Day 1: Baltra to Quito

We hope you enjoyed your Galapagos cruise! Fly from Baltra, to Guayaquil, to Quito (included in price). You'll be met by our local representative who will escort you to your hotel. Settle in for a good night's sleep before a week full of adventures.

## Day 2: Quito + Flight to Lima

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before taking a colonial walking city tour of Quito. This World Cultural Heritage Site is filled with cobblestone streets and stunning architecture. You will see the Government Palace and the La Compañía. Transfer to Quito's airport for your flight to Lima.

## Day 3: Lima to Sacred Valley

Today you'll journey to Sacred Valley. The first photo stop is at the transition weaving town of Chinchero. Lunch will be at a charming, artifact-filled estate. After checking into your hotel, enjoy a trail hike, make traditional Inca beverages, or relax before dinner.

## Day 4: Sacred Valley

Take a walking tour of Ollantaytambo, a living Incan town. Learn the religious importance of this hill town from atop the ruins with views of the Sacred Valley. Stroll the town's streets and visit the markets. Enjoy the spa facilities at your hotel, explore, or take a hike after lunch.

### Day 5: Machu Picchu

Ride the Vistadome 501. Drop off luggage in Aguas Calientes. Transfer to Sanctuary Lodge for lunch. Then, walk to Inca Bridge and spend the afternoon on a guided tour of Machu Picchu archaeological sites. Take in the breathtaking views before heading to your hotel.

### Day 6: Machu Picchu to Cusco

Hike Machu Picchu Mountain (strenuous), relax at the hotel, take a hotel-hosted tour, or check out the ruins. Enjoy a lunch at the hotel and shop or explore afterwards. Then, depart on the Vistadome 304. You will arrive in Ollantaytambo and then transfer by road to Cusco.
