

# **ALASKA CRUISE PACKING CHECKLIST**

#### **CLOTHING TO PACK**

- □ Lightweight, waterproof hiking boots
- □ Sneakers, sandals or casual shoes
- □ Calf-high "Wellington" rubber boots (if recommended)
- □ Waterproof raincoat and pants
- □ Synthetic and/or wool items:
  - ♦ Long sleeve shirts (light-colored, tightly woven)
  - ♦ Short sleeve shirts
  - ♦ Long pants (not denim or cotton)
  - ♦ Shorts (just in case!)
  - ♦ Long underwear style pants
- □ Socks
- □ Jacket, fleece or sweater
- □ Hat
- □ Gloves
- □ Underwear
- □ Swimsuit
- □ Sun/rain hat with strap
  - \*Special note on pants, shorts and shirts: lightweight blends and quick-dry synthetics, such as those found at <u>AdventureSmith Outfitters</u>, are excellent choices for this type of travel.

#### **OPTIONAL ITEMS**

- □ Hiking poles
- □ Reading material or field travel guide
- □ Travel diary and pen/pencil
- □ Mosquito head net

## **HEALTH & FIRST AID**

- □ Aspirin or pain reliever
- □ Band aids
- □ Hand sanitizing gel
- □ Antacid
- Motion sickness tablets, patch, wristbands or homeopathic remedy
- □ Antiseptic lotion for cuts
- □ Medication for insect bites
- □ Prescription medication(s)

#### PERSONAL ITEMS

- □ Sunglasses with strap (polarized lenses recommended)
- □ Belt or pouch for valuables
- Daypack
- □ Extra eyeglasses
- □ Small flashlight or headlamp with extra batteries
- Earplugs
- □ Camera, memory cards and other photo equipment
- □ Binoculars (a pair for each traveler recommended)
- ☐ Insect repellent (store in plastic bag to prevent leakage)
- □ SPF (30 or greater) sunscreen, skin moisturizer
- □ Lip balm with sunscreen
- □ Toiletries
- □ Water bottle
- □ Watch or travel alarm
